Mrs, Mr, Dear Customer,

As a user of chemical solutions in the field of surface treatments, we are considered under the REACH regulation as a downstream user and have therefore no obligation to register. In general, it can be considered that the substances formed in a bath during the process are not to be recorded, as well as the deposits made on your parts.

In addition, our suppliers are all European companies that perform all mandatory registration procedures, which allows us to secure our supplies.

However, we can declare that our productions are exempt within the meaning of the Reach regulation of the 241 substances on the Candidate List including the new substance included in the list since June 27th, 2024.

We can also confirm that, in accordance with the RoHS European directive, the metals we deposit during our processes are free of lead, mercury, cadmium and hexavalent chromium.

We hope that this information will satisfy you and remain at your disposal for any further information.
